

Camp Kit List

Helpful hints

- ★ Please get your Beaver/Cub/Scout to help you pack, so they know where everything is.
- ★ All items should be clearly labelled with the Cub's name.
- ★ Look at the weather forecast as a guide when packing.
- ★ Old clothes are best as they may get damaged or lost.
- ★ Ensure you complete the Medical form.

They will need two bags. A rucksack for the hike and a bag for their camp gear.

For the hike in the afternoon

- ★ Waterproof warm coat / hat / gloves.
- ★ Decent boots, shoes or trainers.
- ★ Rucksack with a drink & snack.

For the camp

- ★ Wash bag containing toothbrush, toothpaste, soap etc.
- ★ 1 Towel
- ★ Pyjamas / Onesie
- ★ Pillow
- ★ Sleeping bag
- ★ Change of outdoor footwear
- ★ Slippers
- ★ 2 sets of trousers, t-shirts/tops, underwear, socks
- ★ 1 warm jumper / fleece
- ★ Torch
- ★ Cuddly toy if they want
- ★ Book
- ★ £5 cash for the shop (optional)
- ★ Any personal medical requirements
- ★ Plastic bag to put in their old clothes

What not to bring

- ★ Mobile phones.
- ★ Electronic games or expensive gadgets / toys.
- ★ The kids don't need to bring plates, bowls or cutlery.
